



Admission Guidelines

- Members with current Membership and Cards get in with free admission.
- If a membership card is stamped with FAMILY, it is good for two parents and children under the age of 16.
- R & T Lifetime Membership Card is only good for 1 person's admission.
- Membership Cards are punched for the current day, once the card is punched, the holder can only go in the gate with a hand stamp. The card is only good for the first entry of the day.
- Exhibitor, Food and Flea Market Passes – These are the smaller cards (3x5) these cards are punched for the current day. Once the card is punched, the holder can only go in the gate with a hand stamp. The card is only good for the first entry of the day.
- There are smaller Admission Passes that are issued to select individuals. These are the size of a business card and are good for one time only. When this is presented, the card will be collected and the holder can come and go with a hand stamp for the remainder of the same day.
- EVERYONE – must have their Hand Stamped for Re-Entry.
- Feature members and exhibitors must have an exhibitor card or a membership to gain entrance. If neither can be produced, they will have to pay admission.
- The only membership card that can be used for free entry is a Rough and Tumble Membership.
- Visiting Dignitaries and Ministers are permitted to park in the South Lot, enter at no charge and spend the day.
- If a person doesn't have their Membership Card:
 - North Gate: Call Jean Kriebel either via the radio or telephone in the gift shop 717-442-4249 and she can confirm current membership.
 - South Gate: Have the guest go into the gift shop to see Jean to confirm membership.
- If a person wants to renew their Membership or purchase a new membership:
 - North Gate: They will have to pay admission to get in (not to exceed the cost of a membership - \$20.00 individual, \$35.00 Family) give them a receipt and they can take that up to the gift shop to get/renew their membership and she will credit them for their admission.
 - South Gate: Send them into the gift shop to get their membership.
- If a person has an exhibit, they must have either a membership card or an exhibitor card for entry without having to pay admission.



- If someone wants to:
 - “Just Go To The Flea Market”
 - “Just Go In To Eat”

They have to pay admission; both the flea market and the food building are too far from either gate to allow someone to “slip in” and “slip out”

- We do not allow exotic pets of any kind. We allow Dogs, on a leash at all times with a current rabies vaccine.

IF you know your dog to be aggressive, frightened by large crowds, frightened by loud noises, frightened by open flame, LEAVE THEM AT HOME!

- We do not allow bikes of any kind, 1 wheel, 2 wheels, 3 wheels, foot powered scooters, skate boards, etc. We ban these because it is a safety issue for the rider, our guests, and the museum in general.
